Monday, 27 June 2016 to Wednesday, 29 June 2016	<b>Student Subject Information Sessions</b>  <b>Subject Market</b>	Students will receive Subject Handbooks for Stage 6. Sessions will be conducted by Key Learning Area Coordinators so students can gain an insight into the variety of subjects offered in Stage 6.

Wednesday, 20 July 2016	<b>Parent/Student Subject Information Sessions</b>	Students with surnames from <b>A-L attend from 6:30pm – 7:30pm</b> Students with surnames from <b>M–Z attend from 7:30pm – 8:30pm.</b> Parents will have the opportunity to ask questions and gain information around courses offered.
Wednesday, 20 July 2016	<b>Students Leaving in Year 10</b>	An information session held between 5:30pm – 6:30pm to discuss options for students wishing to transition into and apprenticeship or work.
Thursday, 21 July 2016	<b>Preliminary expression of Interest for subject selection closes at 9am</b>  <i>(WYD Students must submit BEFORE leaving)</i>	Students will be asked to express an interest in the subjects that are being offered by completing a Google form. This will enable the creation of subject lines.  <b>Please note:</b> Courses are offered based on student numbers, therefore some courses may not be offered in 2017.
Monday, 1 August 2016 and Tuesday, 2 August 2016	<b>Year 11, 2017 Enrolment Interviews</b>	Scheduled interviews will take place to discuss subject choices. Available appointment times will be allocated by the College. Final subject selection forms are to be brought to the interview.
